EXPORTAÇÕES PARA OS EUA: NOVOS REQUISITOS DE CERTIFICAÇÃO

Caro cliente,

Informamos que, a **partir de 8 de julho de 2026**, os importadores de produtos de consumo para os Estados Unidos da América sujeitos a certificação pela U.S. Consumer Product Safety Commission (CPSC) passam a estar obrigados à transmissão eletrônica, através do sistema Automated Commercial Environment (ACE), dos dados dos respectivos Certificates of Compliance.

Esta obrigação decorre da alteração ao **16 CFR Part 1110 – Certificates of Compliance** e aplica-se aos produtos regulados pela CPSC sujeitos a certificação, incluindo, consoante o produto, a emissão de **Children's Product Certificate (CPC)** ou de **General Certificate of Conformity (GCC)**.

No setor têxtil e do vestuário, poderá assumir particular relevância para produtos sujeitos a requisitos de segurança da CPSC, designadamente regras de inflamabilidade aplicáveis a têxteis e vestuário destinados ao mercado norte-americano.

Não se trata de uma autorização prévia de exportação, mas sim de uma obrigação de transmissão eletrônica de dados de certificação no âmbito do processo de importação. A ausência, incorreção ou insuficiência desses dados poderá originar atrasos, retenções, exames adicionais ou recusa de entrada/desalfandegamento da mercadoria nos EUA.

Recomendamos aos Associados com operações para os EUA que articulem previamente com os respetivos importadores norte-americanos, clientes e/ou Representantes Aduaneiros (customs brokers), de modo a confirmar se os produtos exportados estão abrangidos por requisitos de certificação CPSC e quais os dados necessários para efeitos de eFiling no ACE.

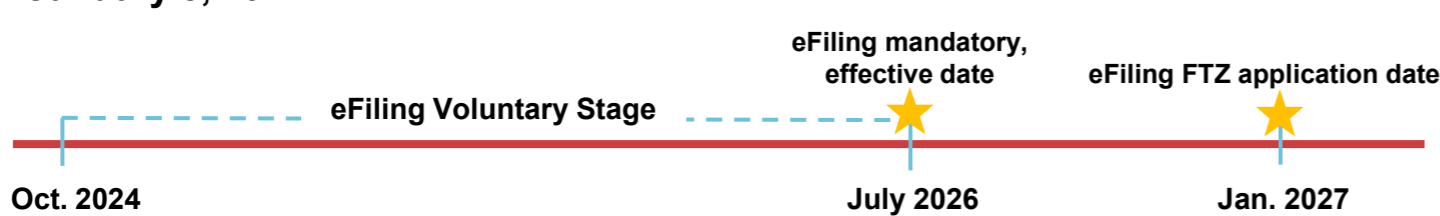

EXPORTS TO THE U.S.: NEW CERTIFICATION REQUIREMENTS

Dear Customer,

We would like to inform you that, **effective July 8, 2026**, importers of consumer products into the ****United States**** that are subject to certification by the ****U.S. Consumer Product Safety Commission (CPSC)**** will be required to electronically submit the relevant ****Certificates of Compliance**** data through the ****Automated Commercial Environment (ACE)**** system.

This requirement results from the amendment to **16 CFR Part 1110 — Certificates of Compliance** and applies to CPSC-regulated products that require certification, including, depending on the product, the issuance of a **Children’s Product Certificate (CPC)** or a **General Certificate of Conformity (GCC)**.

Within the textile and apparel industry, this requirement may be particularly relevant for products subject to CPSC safety regulations, especially flammability standards applicable to textiles and clothing intended for the U.S. market.

Please note that this is not a prior export authorization requirement. Rather, it is an obligation to electronically submit certification data as part of the import process. Missing, inaccurate, or incomplete information may result in delays, cargo holds, additional inspections, or refusal of entry/customs clearance in the United States.

We recommend that customers exporting to the U.S. coordinate in advance with their U.S. importers, customers, and/or customs brokers to confirm whether their exported products are subject to CPSC certification requirements and to identify the information required for ACE eFiling.
